1. Kent Houghton, Chairman – Meeting called to order 9:33 A.M.

- Approval of the last meeting minutes.
- There were no objections or corrections noted to the March 24 or June 23 meetings.
- Mark Compton made the motion to approve the minutes as written.
- Kim McCarter seconded the motion.
- The minutes were approved by a unanimous voice vote.

2. Report to MSTAC- Kent Houghton addressed the meeting and gave a summary of the activities of the Office of Coal Mine Safety for the quarter. He visited every coal mine in the state during the quarter and met with their respective safety departments. He gave an overview of the mining industry and coal mine safety in the state. He attended the Sevier County and Carbon County LEPC meetings. The Safe Operator of the Year Underground Coal Mine Award was awarded to

the SUFCO mine. The safe Operator of the Year Underground Small Coal Mine Award was awarded to the Lila Canyon mine. He attended a training sessions at the USU Eastern mining department.

3. **Old Business** – Thomas Hethmon’s proposals on the Coal Mine Safety Commission Recommendations were brought forward from the last meeting for discussion by the members. The recommendation that the University of Utah, Center for Mine Safety and Health Excellence (The Center) be designated the Utah Research Center for Mine Safety and Productivity, the Center develop a safety roundtable for government agencies and the Center conduct a symposium on ‘mine bumps’ in coal mines and improve mine safety in coordination with the MSTAC and BLM was motioned by Thomas Hethmon to be a recommendation by the MSTAC to the Legislature and Governors office on the annual report.
 - o Thomas Hethmon made the motion to adopt the proposal and seek funding.
 - o Kim McCarter seconded the motion.
 - o The motion was put to a vote and passed by a majority voice vote.
 - o Mark Wheatley will do some research with the legislature to determine the best way to proceed with the motion and will get back with Kent Houghton.

4. **New Business** – There as some discussion that every coal mine should have a member on the council even as a non voting member, Kent Houghton will research this further as to the statutes or requirements and it will be brought forth for discussion at the next meeting.

5. **Adjourn** – There was no further business to discuss and there were no objections.
