Re: Restorative Services Authorization

The Industrial Accidents Division is incorporating three (3) new forms for the purpose of authorizing or denying restorative services requests. These forms replace the existing Form 221 and are as follows:

Restorative Services Authorization/Denial – Spine (Form 221a)
Restorative Services Authorization/Denial – Upper Extremity (Form 221b)
Restorative Services Authorization/Denial – Lower Extremity (Form 221c)

These forms were created through the work of the Medical Committee and include input from both adjusters and providers. The intent in their creation was to allow more specificity for the request and is intended to improve the authorization and treatment process. These forms are now on-line for your convenience at:
