## Instructions On How To Complete the Late Wage Payment Penalty Form

**IMPORTANT**: Please use the Late Wage Payment Penalty Form <u>only</u> if your employer has paid you in full but you received your paycheck <u>late</u> (past the date your employer was obligated to pay you). If you have <u>not been paid in full</u> (regardless of whether your paycheck was late), you need to complete the Wage Claim Assignment Form.

- 1. It is very important that you complete the entire 2 page form and do not leave any blanks. Please make sure to send or fax all 2 pages to us.
- 2. We will have to reject your claim if you do not include:
  - a. Employer name (page 1)
  - b. Employer contact information (page 1)
  - c. Total amount of penalty you are claiming (page 1)
  - d. The dates wage payment(s) were due and the dates you received the wage payment(s) (page 1)
- 3. Make sure that you date and sign the form. If you are under 18, an adult guardian must *also* sign the form. (page 2)

## You Should Also Know:

- The work you did must have been *performed in Utah*, regardless of where the Company is actually located.
  - o If you worked outside of Utah, you will have to contact the labor department in the state where you performed the work.
  - However, if you worked as a long-haul truck driver, and the office that dispatched you is located in Utah, you may file with us even if you live out of state.
- You can only claim the late wage payment penalty with this office if you are or were an employee.
- File *only* if you are claiming late wage payment penalty between \$50 and \$10,000.
- Claim must be filed within *1 year* of the date of the late wage payment(s).
- If your claim is for overtime pay, or for Davis Bacon wages, you must contact the US Department of Labor to file your claim there.
